Healthcare Facilities

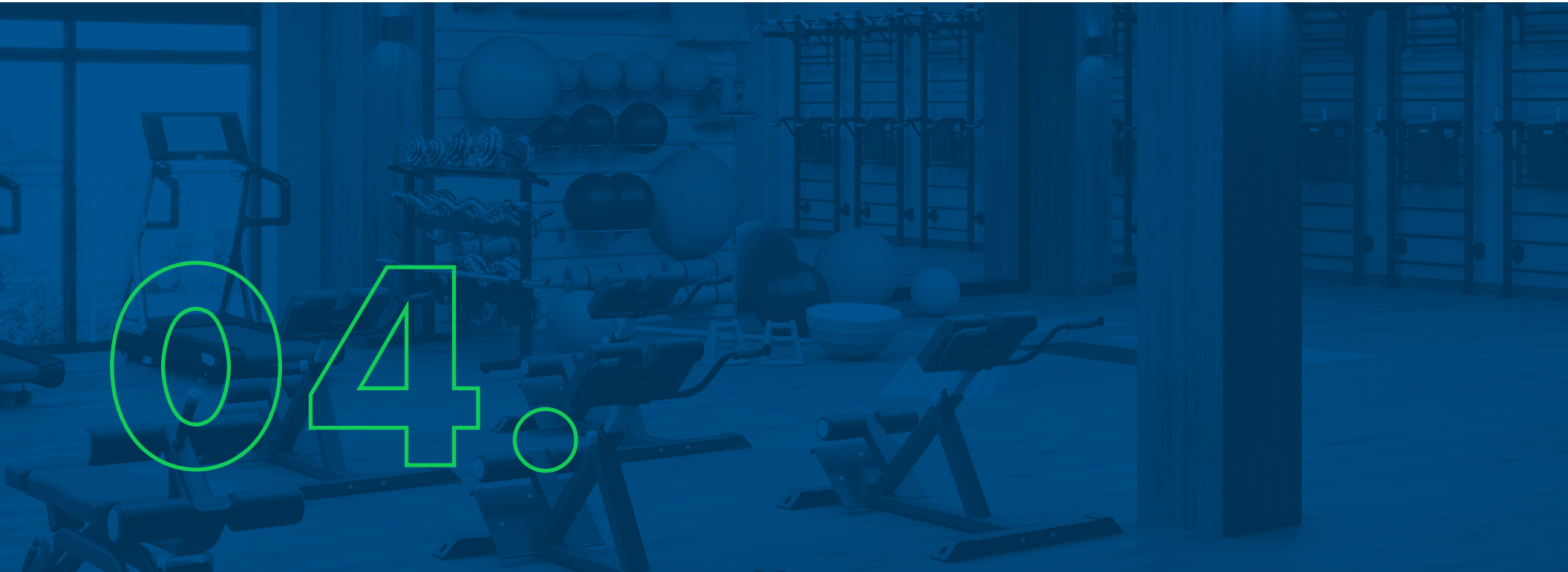
